The Spanish Cannabinoid Research Society (SEIC) will organize the 23<sup>rd</sup> edition of its annual meeting as a joint event for cannabinoid researchers from Spain and France. The meeting will be held in Bordeaux (Centre Broca Nouvelle-Aquitaine, Bordeaux, France) from November 23 to 25, 2023.

## Registration

The participation in the Meeting will require previous registration and payment of the corresponding fee. The registration process will imply the following steps:

The deadline for completing the whole registration process will be **October 23**, **2023**. If vacants were available, registrations will be accepted after October 23 with an extra charge. Individuals who are not registered will not be allowed to enter the Meeting.

The organization will provide some **travel grants** to students. The number and amount of the grants will depend on the funds available for this purpose. The applicants must be SEIC-member or French PhD or postdoctoral students who will give an oral or poster presentation at the meeting. Students who wish to apply for these travel grants must indicate this option in the registration form up till **September 15, 2023**.

## **Abstract presentation**

Those attending the symposium will have the opportunity to present their results in any aspect of cannabinoid research as either oral or poster communication. This will require the submission of an abstract summarizing the most important aspects of the work to be presented. For the preparation of the abstract, the following quidelines must be followed:

Language: English

Font: Times New Roman 12Maximal length: 1 A4 sheet

Margins: 2.5 cm

Title: use CAPS and bold font

• The name of the presenting author should appear <u>underlined</u>

• The affiliation should be written in *italics* 

 At the end of the abstract include 2-3 key words and whether the work is intended for oral o poster communication

If you wish to submit an abstract (for oral or poster presentation), complete the Registration Form and please upload your file. The deadline for abstract submission will be **September 15, 2023**. Abstracts received after that date will be evaluated and accepted only if there is availability for presentation. Abstracts will be evaluated by the Scientific Committee and, if accepted, will be scheduled for poster (maximum height: 135 cm; maximum width: 90 cm) or oral communication (10 min). The official language of the Meeting for all scientific presentations and discussions will be English.
